<p style="text-align: center;"><u>Faith</u></p> <p>a conviction or state of the mind when trust and confidence is placed in God where there is no evidence or proof</p>	<p style="text-align: center;"><u>Hebrews 11:1</u></p> <p>Now faith is being sure of what we hope for and certain of what we do not see. James 5:16 - The effectual fervent prayer of a righteous man availeth much.</p>	<p style="text-align: center;"><u>Symptoms</u></p> <p>exhibiting or marked by <u>great intensity of feeling</u>; stresses sincerity and <u>steadiness of emotional intense heat</u></p>
<p style="text-align: center;">Dead faith</p>	<p>James 2:17 - In the same way, faith by itself, if it is not accompanied by action, is dead.</p>	<p>lacking power to move or create an effect; talks a good game but never moves into action; useless & unproductive; incapable of being stirred emotionally</p>
<p style="text-align: center;">Little Faith</p>	<p>Matthew 11:30-31 But when <u>he saw</u> the wind, <u>he was afraid</u> and, beginning to sink, cried out, "Lord, save me!" 31Immediately Jesus reached out his hand and caught him. "You of <u>little faith</u>," he said, "<u>why did you doubt?</u>"</p>	<p>existing to an appreciable though not extensive degree or amount; not much emotion; easily overcome by doubt and fear</p>
<p style="text-align: center;">Great Faith</p>	<p>Luke 7:7-9 But <u>say the word</u>, and my servant <u>will be healed</u>.⁸For I myself am a <u>man under authority</u>, with soldiers under me. <u>I tell this one</u>, 'Go,' and he goes; and that one, 'Come,' and he comes. <u>I say to my servant</u>, 'Do this,' and he does it."⁹<u>When Jesus heard</u> this, he was amazed at him, and turning to the crowd following him, he said, "I tell you, I have not found such <u>great faith</u> even in Israel."</p>	<p>remarkable in magnitude, degree, or effectiveness; full of emotion; accepts Gods word as sovereign authoritative truth</p>
<p style="text-align: center;">Persistent Faith</p>	<p>Romans 4:18-19 <u>Against all hope</u>, Abraham in hope believed and so became the father of many nations, just as it had been <u>said to him</u>, "So shall your offspring be."¹⁹<u>Without weakening in his faith</u>, he faced <u>the fact that his body was as good as dead</u>—since he was about a hundred years old—and that <u>Sarah's womb was also dead</u>.</p>	<p>passionately continuing to exist despite interference or treatment; existing way beyond usual time or continuously persisting in spite of opposition</p> <p><i>(Why we teach at PLM to Water your seed daily - what you see should never control what you believe)</i></p>
